Instructions: Refrigerator/freezer temperatures shall be monitored and recorded daily. Staff members shall be assigned to monitor and record the refrigerator temperature daily during the department's business operation. Refrigerator temperature should fall between 2 C to 8 C. Freezer temperature should fall between -10 C to -20 C. Indicate the reading by placing an "X" in the column that corresponds with the correct date of the temperature. If any readings occur outside the acceptable range, adjust the temperature dial up or down. Discard any food items when the temperature exceeds the acceptable range. Notify Facilities Management if corrective actions do not produce intended results (i.e., refrigerator still too cold or too warm).

NOTE: To monitor freezer temp., either record freezer temperature reading or place ice cube with a penny on top in a styrofoam cup. Temperature is within range unless the ice cube melts and the penny shifts location.
